Disabilities and Mental Health Reports – Child Plus Report 3502

- 11.4% Head Start
- 16.9% center wide; state average is 9.44% and the national average is 15%.
- 31 students with concerns- 5 waiting to be evaluated and the remainder are receiving interventions through the MTSS (Multi Tiered Supports and Services)

Family and Community Report – Child Plus Report 4003
