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What is Title I?

Lakeview Academy (LVA) is identified as a Ttile I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). What is it?

Partnership

Lakeview Academy will host the following events to build strong family engagement to support a partnership among the school, parents, and the community to support student achievement.

✓ Open House

✓ Annual Title 1 Meeting

Come learn and discuss our Title I Program, parent and family engagement policy, school wide plan, and schoolparent compact. Stakeholders will have the opportunity to provide feedback.

✓ Parent-Teacher Conference

Meet with your child's teacher to discuss your child's progress, academic assessment results and strategies to support academic progress. Conferences can be in person, virtual, or via telephone.

✓ Assessment Parent Meeting

LVA will provide opportunities for parents to better understand the assessments their child will be taking and how to interpret the data collected from the assessment.

✓ Title 1 Parent/Family Workshops

LVA will hold workshops for parents that focus on improving their child's academic achievement such as literacy training and using technology. Additional workshops topics will be determined by analyzing school data and Title I parent Surveys.



✓ Title I Revisions

Parents will be provided with various opportunities to provide input and feedback on the Parent and Family Engagement Plan, School wide plan, school-parent compact, and family engagement budget.

Transition Programs

Administrators will work together with grade level teachers and the Family engagement specialist to provide assistance with transitioning to the next grade level.

Transition workshops will be provided to Lakeview Primary families as they prepare for their student to enter third grade. Middle school transition events will be jointly planned by Lakeview Academy and Oak Hill Middle School faculties to prepare fifth graders for the transition to middle school.

Professional Learning for School Personnel

Lakeview Academy will provide multiple professional learning opportunities that focus on building ties between home and school and communicating with families as equal partners.

District Goal

All students will reach high standards at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in reading/language arts and mathematics on the state assessment.

School Goal and Focus Areas

Lakeview Academy will increase the percentage of students reading on grade level.
