5. Hours must be logged via paper or electronically and shared with the media center by
December 2, 2021, Semester One May 5, 2022 Semester Two

(Late entries will not be accepted).

General Expectations:

The teacher must submit reading logs of students completing hours/ and activities completed with books and appropriate reading responses or projects.

Writing responses must be completed by the student, and detailed to count as an activity.

Expectations for Readers who go above and beyond the semester reading expectations:

1. 5th grader who completes 25 more books, with writing responses, and any project created of their favorite book!
2. 4th grader who completes 25 more books, with writing responses, and any project created of their favorite book!
3. 3rd grader who completes 25 more books, with writing responses, and any project created of their favorite book!

If allowed, we will have a pizza party for all of our readers who meet the semester's reading goals.

If not allowed, the top class of students meeting reading goals each semester will receive a popcorn party.
