Transition Programs

MHA Admin work together with grade level teachers and the Family engagement specialist to provide assistance with transitioning to the next grade level.

Transition collaborations provide Midway Hills Primary families opportunities to visit MHA experience a *Day in the life of a Mustang* as they prepare for their student to enter third grade. Middle school transition events are planned by Midway Hills Academy and Oak Hill Middle School to prepare fifth graders for the transition to middle school.

Professional Learning for School Personnel

Midway Hills Academy provides multiple professional learning opportunities that focus on building connections and relationships among families and MHA staff.
