#### What is MAP?

The Measures of Academic Progress, or MAP is a formative assessment that is given to your child three times each year. This is an untimed, multiple -choice test that is taken on a computer. It is both adaptive (adjusts to the level of difficulty appropriate for your child), as well as diagnostic (identifies specific strengths of your child in specific areas).

# What is the Purpose of MAP?

MAP results allow for teachers to understand how to respond to individual student learning needs, monitor progress and differentiate instruction. MAP assessments are based on a growth model that provides information regarding student learning from Fall to Spring and from year to year.

#### What academic areas will be tested?

The students will be tested in three areas: Math, Reading and Language Usage

# When will my child take MAP?

Three times per year: July/August (Fall testing window)
November/December (Winter testing Window March/April (Spring testing Window)

#### What is the RIT Score?

This is the student's overall score on the assessment. The score is unrelated to age or grade of the student, but reflects at the level at which the student is currently performing.

#### Tips for Parents:

Meet with your child's teacher as often as needed to discuss progress. Parents and teachers working together will benefit students.

Provide a quiet, comfortable place for studying at home.

Make sure your child is well rested on school days.

Give your child a well-rounded diet. A healthy body leads to a healthy, active mind.

Provide books and magazines for your child to read at home or read aloud with your child. Research shows that this is the most important activity that parents can do to increase their child's chance of reading success.
